Stage Makeup... How To Level III+

Products You Will Need:

Face Primer
Foundation (No SPF)
Concealer
Face Powder
Bronzer
Blush
Highlighter
Brown, Gold, Cream Shimmer Eyeshadow
Black Liquid Eyeliner

Eyelash Curler (Optional)
Black Mascara
Fake Eyelashes (Optional)
Eyebrow Pencil
Maroon Lipstick
Setting Spray
Face and Eye Makeup Brushes

1: Start with a clean face. Apply face primer to the face and let it dry. Next apply an even coat of a foundation of your choice, preferably a foundation with no SPF, all over the face and all the way down the neck. Next take your concealer and apply this under the eyes and on any blemishes or redness. Finish off with a layer of face powder.

2: Apply bronzer underneath the cheek bones and on the temples of the forehead, essentially anywhere the light would hit the lowest points on the face. Next apply blush to the apples of the cheeks, blending backwards. Finish with some of your highlighter on the top of the cheekbones and apply backwards avoiding the apples of the cheeks.

3: Apply your brown eyeshadow all over the eyelid, working it in circular motions into the crease of the eye. Once that is all applied, use the gold eyeshadow all over the eyelid, avoiding the crease, but blending the two colors together. Next apply the cream colored eyeshadow on the brow bone and on the inside of the eyelid. Next apply a very thin line of black liquid eyeliner on the top lash line of the eyelid and let dry. Finish with curling the eyelashes with the eyelash curler, if one is accessible to you, and then 2-3 coats of black mascara on the top and bottom eyelashes.

*Fake eyelashes are not required but highly suggested. If you do have fake eyelashes, this is the time to apply them. We recommend using the magnetic eyelashes that can be purchased at the drugstore. Most come with a black liquid eyeliner, if so you will not need to purchase an extra black liquid eyeliner. You will need to take the black liquid eyeliner that comes with the fake eyelashes and apply a thin line to the top of the lash line of the eyelid and let it dry half way. Finish with taking the fake eyelashes and lining them up with the eyeliner and they will stick on to your eyelid right away. Let set for a couple of minutes after this.

4: To finish off the look, lightly fill in your eyebrows with the eyebrow pencil going in outward strokes. Next apply an even coat of maroon lipstick on the dancers lips. Have them blot their lips with a tissue and apply once more. Take the finishing spray and spritz all over the face, lightly, and you are all finished!

Hair Tutorial:

For our performance hair we always part the hair on the left side of the head. The hair should be slicked back with a comb into a low pony that is based in the middle of the head. Finish by putting in the hair piece with the silver side up and an even coat of hairspray all over the head!
